Aims of education			
Modern maritime law aims to deal with global problems. The intention of the lecture is to present the essence of international maritime law and its unique role in the context of maritime safety and the prevention of pollution from ships. The course covers several basic areas of protection and ship			

management in accordance with the principle of sustainable development. The lecture covers important elements: global ocean law and policy for climate protection and sustainable ocean governance, inter alia legal standards building resilience to global ocean threats, as well as the role of the European Union in the ocean management process, sustainable shipping, marine spatial planning, combating illegal, unregulated and unreported fishing, as well as maritime security.
